We will do a school meeting role-play. That means we will pretend to be in a big meeting at school, like an assembly.

In this activity:

- Each of you will play a role (for example: student, teacher, parent, principal, cafeteria worker...).
- We will talk about a school problem (like homework, uniforms, recess, or food in the cafeteria).
- Everyone must speak in English and share their ideas.
- You should listen carefully to others and respond politely, even if you don't agree.

At the end, you will try to find a solution together.



Principal - the leader of the meeting, keeps order, makes the final decision.

Teacher – talks about classwork, homework, or rules.

Parent – shares concerns about their child's learning, safety, or happiness.

Student – wants changes (less homework, more recess, etc.).


TES- works with students and teachers to assure a good functioning inside as well as outside the class.


Presenter- Presents the team and topic. Summarises the opinions of each team member and highlights the solutions.



THE STEPS

- Make a team of 5/6 students.
- Choose your topic of discussion.
- Choose your role.
- Work individually on your opinions. Each opinion should have a justification.
- Get into the team to share your ideas. Try to find a solution together.
